For her latest project, FIND ME, visual artist Gema Álava approached artists Lars Chellberg, Barbara Holub, Paul Kos, Ester Partegás, Robert Ryman, Arne Svenson, Merrill Wagner, Lawrence Weiner and Maria Yoon and asked them to each create an artwork with the express understanding that she would hide it somewhere in the public eye, but not reveal its exact location.

Some artworks, in the form of installation, sculpture, painting, photography, an audio piece and an artist book, have already been placed in the Tenderloin District of San Francisco (June 2009), and others will be placed in suitable locations in New York, NY, in September 2009.

Álava has also made several artists' books that include photographs and documentation of the artworks, as well as more specific information about where they may be found. In just one of these books does she reveal the exact location

of each piece. This volume, titled FIND ME 2.0, has itself been placed on a shelf in San Francisco's Main Library and Federal Depository.

A presentation of these hidden pieces and one of the artists' books will take place at **CUE ART FOUNDATION on October 8th, 2009, from 6 to 8pm**, with the participating artists in attendance. This event will not be repeated.

It is the artist's intention that all the artworks involved will remain in their chosen locations until they are discovered.
