At the same time you are independently creating work for your portfolio and exhibit, you will work together as a team to develop professional skills, acquire key tools to assist in obtaining a higher education and explore career options. jumpstART gives you the opportunity to work closely with artists, designers, printers, curators and arts administrators—giving you exposure to the broad spectrum of career opportunities in the arts. During the Fall semester you focus on skill and portfolio development, and at the end of the spring semester an exhibition of your work will be on view at CUE's Chelsea gallery space for a week with a public opening reception, giving hundreds of people a chance to see and appreciate your art.
